

RACE REPORT

Round 2 - National F1 BEARS Championships McNamara Park, Mount Gambia, South Australia

11th & 12th April 2009

The North Coast V-Twins Race Team has just returned from the F1 Bears Easter Cup in Mount Gambier South Australia where Beau Beaton on the V-Twins Ducati 1198s dominated again winning nine out of ten top division races he contested over the weekend.

Beau led from start to finish in all races except Race 7 with a crash on the first lap causing his only hiccup of the meeting. With a new back tyre on the bike, Beau found the bush in the first lap of this race. Fortunately Beau came out of the incident unscathed, and with minimal damage to the Ducati he was able to complete the race gaining valuable championship points.

The highlight of the meeting was Beau setting yet another lap record on his superstock Ducati with treaded tyres. He posted a new F1 Bears fastest lap time of 1m 13.32s at McNamara Park, beating the previous record held since 2007 by nationally acclaimed rider John Allen.

After three rounds of this series, Beau is presently leading the championship table having missed Round 2 due to a clash in dates with the Australian Superstock Titles.
